Item No. 11 August 4, 2014	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>M.A. N. 751 of 2013</u></p> <p>It is stated despite removal debris are laying in the forest area. Let the Gurgaon Municipal Corporation remove the debris at the cost of the shop owners who are located in that area. All the shop keepers and the Members of the Association shall pay the money demand within two days in advance, to enable the Corporation to remove the debris. Let the removal of debris be brought to the notice of the Tribunal on the next date of hearing.</p> <p>In the meanwhile, the Forest Department and the State of Haryana will also bring on record what is the survival rate of the trees planted in that area and if the same is less, reason thereof.</p> <p>We make it clear that no machinery will be used by these shopkeepers and if it is used, the Corporation/ Forest Department can seize such machines.</p> <p>The Forest Department will ensure that all varieties of trees are planted, if not already planted.</p>
