Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Balotara Textile Hand Processers Associations the newly impleaded respondent no. 11 to the present application submits that besides seeking their impleadment they had also sought modification of the order dated 9th July, 2015 on the ground that they are the association of the industrial units dealing with washing of the cloths and considering their industrial activity they need to be permitted to operate particularly when their industrial units are connected to CETP by closed conduit pipes.
