<b>Item No. 1&amp;2 September 14, 2015</b>	<p>Heard. Perused.</p> <p>Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the State of Rajasthan submits that the State has moved the MoEF for revising the previous parameters for treating water from CETPs situate in the district of Pali, Barmer and Jodhpur vide representation dated 6th August, 2015. He also points out that a reminder has been sent vide letter dated 07-09-2015 and yet the MoEF has to respond to the said representation. Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the MoEF submits that they are considering the said representation and the issues involved in it and would take definite stand by 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2015.</p> <p>Learned Counsel appearing for the applicant</p>

submits that he will like to respond to the said representation and therefore he may also be furnished with the copy of the representation. Copy of the representation is furnished to the applicant.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Balotara Textile Hand Processers Associations the newly impleaded respondent no. 11 to the present application submits that besides seeking their impleadment they had also sought modification of the order dated 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 on the ground that they are the association of the industrial units dealing with washing of the cloths and considering their industrial activity they need to be permitted to operate particularly when their industrial units are connected to CETP by closed conduit pipes. We had disposed of the application for impleadment M.A. NO. 849/2015 merely by passing directions to implead the respondent no. 11 and the prayer for modification was not considered. The applicant as well the concerned respondents namely, the respondent no. 1 State, respondent no. 6 RIICO and respondent no. 7 Rajasthan Pollution Control Board shall respond to this application viz. a viz. the modification sought. Keep this application along with the main application on the next date of hearing.
