Bhushan Steel & Strips Limited was directed to be shut down and certain other directions were passed with reference for compliance by the industry. The industry complied with the directions contained in the said Judgment and applied to the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board for inspection and analysis of its trade effluents in terms of order of the Tribunal joint inspection conducted by Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board, Central Pollution Control Board and I.I.T., Delhi twice and thereafter report has been filed. The joint inspection team has reported that the industry is complying and non-polluting. Certain queries were also raised by the Tribunal vide its order dated 11th February, 2016 to which the industry has filed detailed reply. The stand taken up also supported by the Central Pollution Control Board. In</p>

Industry should be permitted to carry on its business activity in accordance with law. The joint inspection team Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board and Central Pollution Control Board shall inspect the industry after a regular interval and ensure the trade effluent discharge strictly as per the prescribed parameters.</p> <p>With the above directions M.A. No. 1306 of 2015 stands disposed of. No order as to cost.</p> <p><u>Original Application No. 70 of 2015</u></p> <p>In view of the above the Original Application No. 70 of 2015 does not survive for consideration and disposed of accordingly.
