Since there is no arrangement to engage a Counsel through Legal Aid Services, she has accepted the work as Pro-bono Publica, on gratuitous basis.</p> <p>The Respondent No.3, has filed reply today. The matter is transferred by the Hon'ble High Court, Bench at Nagpur to this Tribunal. Originally it was Writ Petition No.3501 of 2006, which was entertained by the Hon'ble High Court, Bench at Nagpur. Considering the considerable delay in filing the reply by the Respondent No.3, which is Public Limited Company, we direct the Respondent No.3, to pay an amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rs. Twenty Thousand only) to Ms. F.M.Mesquita, as cost within two weeks.</p> <p>We direct the MPCB to submit a report on the air pollution levels in Chandrapur and Ghugus areas and also the air pollution caused due to various major contributing industries/sources, along with status of implementation of Action Plan.
