<b>Date and Remarks</b>	<b>Orders of the Tribunal</b>
<b>Item Nos. 22 to 24 August 24, 2015</b>	<p>The Chief Engineer, Irrigation Department, UP is present. He submits that in order to consider measures for prevention and control of pollution in Hindon Canal and Hindon River, the concerned departments viz Department of Urban Development, U.P. Pollution Control Board, Industries Department and Jal Nigam also need to be summoned. Let the senior officer from the said Departments/Board/Nigam be present before the Tribunal on the next date of hearing. These officers would take clear instructions from the concerned Competent Authorities as to how they would prevent and control pollution of river Yamuna through Hindon Canal and Hindon river which are carrying industrial effluents, municipal solid waste and even sewage. The Hindon river</p>

exclusively passes through the State of Uttar Pradesh while Hindon Canal passes through NCT, Delhi and U.P. No state can permit causing of indiscriminate pollution of waterbody and discharge of heavy pollutants into the river Yamuna spreading pollution in other states as well.

Let this matter be listed on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 the date already fixed on which date they would put up clear proposal before the Tribunal.

We make it clear that we will not grant any further time to these State Governments. NCT, Delhi shall also be at liberty to participate through DJB in the meeting of all the officers of U.P. as afore-indicated. This meeting should be conducted positively on 01<sup>st</sup> September, 2015 at 05:00 PM.
