	Item No. 8 August 26, 2014	<p>Heard. Perused.</p> <p>We have partly heard the parties. Apparently, we find that the laws were thrown to winds and construction of the wall ad measuring about 900 meters in length and 3 meter height had been already carried out in the National Park.</p> <p>Learned Counsel for MoEF pointed out that before granting any such permission, the chief wildlife Warden ought to have sought permission under Section 35, Sub-clause 6 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972 and the activity in question is in clear violation of the provisions of Forest Conservation Act. Learned Counsel appearing for the State seeks time to take instructions from the Government to make a statement that the wall in question will be removed and she would submit to the process of law.</p> <p>List the matter on 23rd September, 2014.</p> <p>....., JM (U.D.
