<p><b>Order No. 6</b></p> <p><b>20<sup>th</sup> November, 2015</b></p>	<p>None for the Applicant. The Chief Chemist from MPPCB Regional Office Sagar submits that so far as the direction with regard to the compliance of Bio Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998 are concerned, notices were given to the health facilities regarding stopping the washing of linen in the lake water.
