<p>Item No. 5 4th March, 2014</p>	<p><u>M.A. No. 126/2014</u></p> <p>This application has been filed by counsel for Bhopal Municipal Corporation(BMP) for taking on record the inspection note prepared in pursuance of the inspection carried out report made by the Mayor of Bhopal to the Shahpura Lake on 3rd March, 2014.</p> <p>This Application is allowed and the inspection report is ordered to be taken on record.</p> <p><u>Original Application No. 34/2013 (CZ)</u></p> <p>Having heard the parties and their learned counsel more particularly in the light of the observations finding place in the inspection report dated 3rd March, 2014 we are of the view that to review the steps taken and for suggesting any additional steps that may be taken, the Executive Engineer from the Municipal Corporation, Bhopal, Sr. Research Officer of EPCO, the Applicant accompanied by Shri Shantnu Saxena, Advocate as Commissioner on behalf of the Court, shall visit the area jointly tomorrow and put forward their suggestions by way of a report containing a rough sketch for the proposed alterations or any proposed construction for ensuring that solid waste is not allowed to flow into the Shahpura Lake and also preventing silting from upstream of the Ekant Park and ensure improvement in the water quality before it enters into the Shahpura Lake at various points.</p> <p>The report be prepared and submitted within 10 days.</p>

Shri Saluja, Executive Engineer, BMC has apprised this Tribunal that pursuant to the directions contained in the order dated 13th February, 2014 the work of removal of solid waste by way of mechanical and manual methods to the extent possible, has been carried out.

Shri Shantnu Sexena, Advocate shall visit the area along with the Municipal Engineer and submit the report regarding the present position prevailing. We further direct Sh. Saluja, Executive Engineer, BMC to also take note of recent Media reports which have appeared with regard to the problems prevailing in the Sahapura Lake and the Nalaha permitting inflow of sewage into the lake as also the work done pursuant to the previous orders passed by the NGT. In case some of the suggestions and problems highlighted by the Media are found to be correct, remedial steps in that behalf shall be taken by the Bhopal Municipal Corporation.
