Date and Remarks	Orders of the Tribunal
	We have heard the Learned Counsel appearing for the parties at some length. Various issues arise for consideration of the Tribunal. However, the question of limitation as well as maintainability of the present application has been raised by the respondents. Learned Counsel appearing for the applicant submits that it is a continuous project containing four phases. First phase has been completed, second phase is about to be completed, third phase is in progress and fourth is still to be started. According to the Learned Counsel appearing for the respondents, the project is a state of art project and is intended to serve a larger public purpose of decongestion of traffic in Delhi. He further states that the linking road by the other States like UP
	has already been completed and the bridge construction

is in progress. He further states upon instruction that the river bank is being used only for temporary purpose as a support to construction of the bridge and the same will be removed once the bridge is completed and the work will be done in non- monsoon season. Having heard the Learned Counsel appearing for the parties and keeping the Doctrine of Sustainable Development we vacate the interim order passed by the Tribunal on 26th October, 2015. However, all constructions made shall be subject to final decision of this application.
