	As far as setting up of CETPs and STPs, to ensure		
	Remarks Item Nos. 15-17 July 28,		

that either they have no discharge by recycling of the treated water or wherever it is necessary, the release from CETPs and STPs would be strictly in accordance with the prescribed parameters. This would be from all the five points in the State of Haryana where the main drain joins river Yamuna that is at Yamuna Nagar-Jagadari, Karnal, Panipat, Sonepat-Samalkha and Kundli.

Let the Maps of the drainage network, location of CETP/STP, the distance between the last CETP/STP on the drain upto its confluence with river Yamuna, and extent of industrial and residential area covered by each STP/CETP and even the proposed development in that area, be submitted to the Tribunal within one week from today. We have also been informed on behalf of the State of Haryana on instruction of senior officers that by 2017, all the CETPs and STPs would be established properly, water would be recycled for minimum discharge into the river Yamuna which will not contain any pollutants. They shall also identify adequacy of each of the CETP and STP to handle effluent load.
