<b>Item No. 12  February 12, 2016 A</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Original Application No. 326 of 2015</u></b></p> <p>We have heard the Learned counsel appearing for the parties.</p> <p>We have also perused the joint inspection report dated 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 filed by the Joint inspection team. The following recommendation have been made in the report:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li><i>1. Kalindi by pass raod which is lying abandoned/incomplete for the years is a project of PWD, Govt. of Delhi about 100 metre (approximately) away from the boundary wall of the colony.</i></li><li><i>2. In compliance to orders dated 13.01.2015 of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in Original Application No. 06 of 2012, the land is to be developed as a is bio-diversity park for which DDA has taken up preliminary work of survey, demarcation and</i></li></ol>

*preparation of the estimate. The creation of bio-diversity make take on and a half to two years and thereafter the problem of mosquito breeding shall be automatically vanished and the grievances of the RWA shall be resolved.*

*3. Hon'ble Tribunal may be requested to direct the SDMC to do anti-mosquito breeding operation in the area till the bio-diversity park is developed by DDA. Otherwise also, it is the mandate of the SDMC also worth to say that problem is also due to discharge of the polluted water from the Maharani Bagh drain owned and maintained by SDMC”.*

We dispose of this Application with directions that the above recommendations shall be carried out by each public authorities and bodies without default and delay.

Certainly the SDMC should ensure spraying of appropriate pesticides and/or other sprays to ensure there is no mosquito breeding in that area. Every effort should also be made to keep the area clean.

In the event of default the Applicant can approach to the Tribunal
