Date and Remarks	Orders of the Tribunal
<b>Item No. 11 September 27, 2013</b>	<p>It is stated that the Learned Counsel appearing for the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) being indisposed is not able to attend the Tribunal and, therefore, adjournment is prayed for.</p> <p>The Inspecting team had inspected 17 hospitals noticed in our order dated 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2013. However, the inspection report thereon has not been filed on record. Let the report be filed within one week from today.</p> <p>It also stated by the Learned Counsel appearing for the Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) that 12 other hospitals in private sector were also inspected by the team and their inspection reports shall also be placed on record within the aforesaid period.</p> <p>It has been brought to our notice that large number of private hospitals/small nursing homes are operating in Delhi</p>

and are violating the Bio-Medical Waste rules and are causing great danger to public health and environment.

We direct the committee constituted by the Tribunal to pay surprise visit for inspection of any of the private nursing homes more particularly smaller nursing homes and submit their report before the next date of hearing in relations to collection, segregation and disposal of BMW.

We direct that this order should be complied with positively before the next date of hearing and the Environmental Scientists/Engineers working in Bio Medical Section of the DPCC should not be burdened with other duty and this order should be complied without any further delay.

This matter would come up for hearing on 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2013 and shall also be listed on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2013 in terms of our previous order.

Liberty to Noticee hospitals to file Additional documents, if any, within three weeks from today.
