Perused.</p> <p>According to the Learned Counsel appearing for the applicant the illegal clay mining which has been captured in the photographs at page 24 to 31 is from the villages of the Mangali, Bijnor (khasra No's. 122, 123, 124, 129, 469, 28), Raghavpur, Bijnor (khasra No's. 147 & 175) and Raipur Tappa Nangal (khasra No's. 33/1 & 33/2), particularly recorded at the annexure-G of the rejoinder dated 30.07.2015.</p> <p>According to the Learned Counsel appearing for the State, there is no instance of clay mining but the civil work of laying pipeline. For resolution of this controversy, we direct Joint Inspection to be conducted by a Team of the DM, Bijnor and UPPCB of said lands and report regarding the condition of the lands as to reveal whether there has been any excavation of soil at the said lands as asserted by the applicant and if yes, to what extent. Advance notice of the Joint Inspection may be given to the applicant who may be at liberty to attend the</p>

proceedings.
