Officer of MPCB, has placed on record his affidavit. We direct the
Regional Officer of MPCB to give further details of coal analysis by
filing additional affidavit and also to give source-wise information, if
available, as regards pollution level stated in the affidavit with

causing pollution and whether proximity of coal depot, is major factor
for the pollution caused, particularly in the premises of school.

We direct that copy of this order be delivered to the office of Collector, Chandrapur by the office of MPCB for the purpose of examining the issue and if required to instruct Mr Mulchandani, about stand which he is required to be taken in the matter.
