Learned Council appearing for the Respondent No. 1-Municipal Council Gardhiwala, submits that the town of Gardhiwala is a small town with population of around 10,000 and has potential of providing 5 to 7 carcasses a month. However, Municipal Council will keep this plant open for the villages in the vicinity for the purposes of disposal of carcasses. We hope that the Committee goes through all the pros and cons of the project of wet rending plant and comes up with some sound solution to the problem of disposal of carcasses at Gardhiwala. Time for study is granted.
