Item No. 2 13th July 2016.	<p>We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the applicant. Admit. Issue notice to the respondents returnable by 28.7.2016.</p> <p>Mr. M.K. Subramaniam and P Velmani takes notice for R2, R3, R5 and R6. Mrs.Rita Chandrasekar takes notice for R7 & R8</p> <p>The learned counsel appearing for the applicant submits that the ninth respondent, who is the manufacturer of edible oil, has not obtained any "consent" from the Pollution Control Board. The information furnished under the Right to Information Act dated 28.6.2016 also supports his contention. It is his case that the tenth respondent manufacturing unit is discharging untreated effluents into the sea and thereby causing pollution to the marine species.</p> <p>In view of the same, there shall be an order of interim stay against the tenth respondent until further orders.</p> <p>We direct the seventh respondent Board through their District Environmental Engineer concerned to inspect the spot concerned and file a status report on the next date of hearing.</p>
