	Item No. 01 June 01, 2015	<p>We have heard the Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant.</p> <p>Admitted. Notice be issued to the Respondents by registered post/acknowledgment due and Dasti as well.</p> <p>Notice returnable by the next date of hearing.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant submits that the area in question has been duly recorded as site for a park and this has been developed by DDA for the past 30 years. However, presently some steps are being taken for the purpose of alienating a portion of the park to 3rd parties. According to the Learned counsel such alienation would not only affect the life of the park but will also encroach into a green area which is part of living space. Therefore, she has pleaded for interim stay. Taking note of the above stated facts that the park has been maintained for the past 30 years by DDA, we are of the considered view that the balance of convenience is in favour preservation of the park. Accordingly Respondents are directed to maintain Status QUO in respect of the park as it exists until further orders.</p> <p>The DDA is directed to produce necessary records in respect of this park on the next date of hearing.</p>
