	Item No. 12 July 20, 2015	<p>The industry would submit before the Tribunal as to how they are dealing with the hazardous waste, where they are disposing their trade effluents which ultimately goes to Common Effluent Treatment Plant and what the industry proposes to do with regard to the possibility of overflow from the tank, whether effluent that is stored in the equalisation tank and what is their corporate social responsibility.</p> <p>In the meanwhile the Board shall collect samples from the outlet of the industry and examine the same as well and shall also submit their report with regard to the disposal of hazardous waste from the industry.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing for the Respondent No. 1 should also submit their comments to the report submitted by the Amacus Curie in this case.</p> <p>We make it clear that this is the last opportunity to all the parties to comply with the directions of the Tribunal.
