	permit/allow respondent no 6 Dhan Singh to
	excavate/mine, without obtaining environmental
	clearance from the appropriate authority and also for a
1	direction to stop illegal mining of respondent no. 6 near
V 11/2	Gata No. 1/20 area 5.69 Acre situated at Village-
	Gharbara District – Aligarh over the agricultural land of
	the applicant.
3	Learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 6
	submits though respondent no.6 was having
	environmental clearance to mine, the period of
	environmental clearance expired on 11.01.2016.
	Learned counsel appearing for State of UP also
	submitted that as the period of environmental clearance
	is already over, respondent no. 6 cannot continue
	mining and the lease has already expired. In the light of
	these submissions nothing survives in the application.
	If the grievance of the applicant is that, without the

authority or permission Respondent no. 6 carried out any mining in his private property he is at liberty to approach the civil court for appropriate relief.
