Issue Notice.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing for MoEF and SEIIA accept Notice and waive service, they pray for time to file replies. Replies be filed within one week from today.</p> <p>List this matter for hearing on 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2016.</p> <p>In the meanwhile the Director, Mines and Geology, Rajasthan shall file a personal affidavit giving complete details of 19,000 mines which have been closed, as per the averments made in para 11 of the Affidavit. It will also be stated as to how many mines were physically inspected before the instant application, supported by an Affidavit, had been filed before the Tribunal to that effect.</p> <p>It is stated that there are 177 mines in district Alwar (Rajasthan) which have been closed and are part of the figure of 19,000 as stated in para 11 of the affidavit. Mr. Sanjeev Ralli, Adv., present before the Tribunal is appointed as Local Commissioner who shall make</p>

surprise visit in district Alwar and would report to the Tribunal, if any mining activity is being carried on in the area which, according to the department, have been closed. He shall conduct a complete and comprehensive inspection. His fee is initially fixed at Rs. 35,000/- in addition to the expenses which the Local Commissioner is called upon to incur. The S.P. of the concerned district is directed to render all help and assistance to the Local Commissioner, to ensure execution of the commission.

Report should be submitted before the next date of hearing.
