The 11 industrial clusters also release 4 MLD of sewage, however, the Officer cannot inform us what is the sewage discharge of Bhiwadi and the surrounding areas. STP of 4 MLD capacity has been installed and another CETP of 6 MLD has been installed. Neither CETP nor STP is discharging treated effluent as per the prescribed parameters.
