	Date and Remarks	Orders of the Tribunal
	Item No. 30 January 21, 2016	<p>We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties. Upon hearing, we pass the following direction:</p> <p>The industry of respondent no. 5 shall not operate for a period of two weeks from 22.01.2016.</p> <p>In the meanwhile, it will take all steps and measures recommended by the Punjab Pollution Control Board and submit an application to the Punjab Pollution Control Board. The premises would be inspected by a joint inspection team consisting of an officer from the Punjab Pollution Control Board and a nominated person from IIT Ropar by the Director of that institute.</p> <p>If the inspection report finds that adequate measures have been taken and it does not violate the prescribed noise pollution standards and there is no vibration caused which would harm the neighbouring persons, the industry would be permitted to operate. In the event the report is found to be against the industry, the industry shall not commence its</p>

operations without specific orders of the Tribunal.

The report shall be submitted to the Tribunal which shall be registered as a separate Original Application and placed before the Tribunal for appropriate orders.

With the above directions, the Original Application No. 543/2015 stands disposed of with no order as to cost.

M. A. No. 1289/2015 & M. A. No. 18/2016 do not survive for consideration as the main application itself stands disposed of.
