<p>Item No. 03</p> <p>August 11, 2015</p>	<p><u>Original Application No. 223 of 2015</u></p> <p>We have perused the joint inspection report.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing for the industry submit that they would comply with the directions specified in the joint inspection report at the earliest. Let them comply with the same and inform the Pollution Control Board. The Pollution Control Board would thereon entertain the application for grant of consent in accordance with law.</p> <p>The question of paying environmental compensation for the past pollution, if any, caused by the industry does arise in this Application. However Learned counsel appearing for the Respondents bring to our notice that this question is directly subjudice in the Original Application No. 29 of 2015 where the industry is required to file reply to the show cause notice.</p> <p>Let the industry comply with the order dated 07th May, 2015 passed in Original Application No. 29 of 2019 within two weeks from today. As the Original Application No. 29 of 2015 has already been disposed of we make it</p>

clear that Central Pollution Control Board and the joint inspection team shall submit a report in relation to the environmental compensation payable for the past pollution caused by the industry as well.

The industry would get their remediation plan for reclamation of soil below the low lying area prepared by the IIT falling within the concerned jurisdiction.

After the submission of the report by the joint inspection team and the Central Pollution Control Board, which will be filed within one month from today, the matter shall be listed before the Tribunal for directions by the Registry.

Copy of the order be given Dasti.

With the above direction, Original Application No. 223 of 2015 stands disposed of without any order as to costs.
