	<b>Date and Remarks</b>	<b>Orders of the Tribunal</b>
	<b>Item No. 01  November 16, 2015 A</b>	<p>It has been brought to the notice of the Tribunal that the municipal solid waste management is very poor at Jammu and Katra and passage upward to Bhawan and Shri Mata Vaishno Devi. Even the dung is dumped and is lying all over the passage which certainly is injurious to health. There is another case pending before the Tribunal, in relation to the diseases being generated as a result of spreading of such waste as well as harm to the wildlife particularly to the Horses.</p> <p>Therefore, we issue Notice to the following, to put a complete action plan in regard to collection, transportation and disposal of municipal solid waste and to remain present before the Tribunal on the next date of hearing:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Municipal Corporation of Jammu through its Commissioner</li><li>2. Shrine Board of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi through its CEO.</li><li>3. Chief Executive Officer of the Katra Municipality.</li><li>4. Union of Workers working from Katra to Bhawan</li></ol>

through its Presidents.

5. Union of Horse owners through their President.

6. Pollution Control Board Jammu & Kashmir through its Member Secretary.

7. Private owners of the properties whose property are located at Ban Ganga and who are permitting sheds for Sharnarhi and are throwing waste on river of Ban Ganga.

Learned counsel appearing for the State of Jammu & Kashmir will ensure that the Notices are served upon all these persons forthwith.

The Registry will issue Notices today itself and provide Dasti to the Learned counsel appearing for the State.

In this matter it is stated that the letter of intent for construction and completion of municipal solid waste to energy plant at Sri Nagar has been allotted and the Contractor has been asked to mobilize the resources for that purpose. Let the said Contractor be also present before the Tribunal on the next date of hearing.
