No. 1078 of 2015</u></p> <p>The applicant, owner of the property-Plot no. 20/6, Village Nilothi, Delhi has moved this application for de-sealing the property on the grounds that he has removed all scrap materials lying outside the property in question and the property is lying vacant without yielding any benefit and he shall not use it for any plastic waste business or anything prohibited by the law.</p>

The applicant has no objection for grant of relief sought in the present application. Considering these submissions, we direct the Deputy Commissioner, North Delhi Municipal Corporation, Narala Zone to de-seal the said property.

In view of the above the M. A. No. 1078 of 2015 stands disposed of accordingly with no order as to cost.
