Item Nos. 8&9 November 24, 2014 A	<p>The Status reports in regard to NCT of Delhi and North Municipal Corporation have been filed.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing for Police Authority and DPCC prays for time to file the Status report. By way of last opportunity two weeks time is granted to file the status report.</p> <p>Let the DPCC, NCT of Delhi, North Municipal Corporation of Delhi issue Notice to 177 Units which are</p>

defaulting and polluting units. Notice should state as to why they be not directed to be close permanently and pay compensation for restoration of the degraded environment resulting from their activities.

Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant has placed on record certain photographs of rampant burning of plastic and other waste material in the various parts of the City which is injurious to human health. Let copies of the same be furnished to all the Learned counsel appearing for Respondents. They shall file an Affidavit responding to these photographs. The Police Authorities shall conduct a physical inspection and check all these places and report to the Tribunal on the next date of hearing.

All the Respondents will be liable to pay cost of Rs. 10000 imposed by the Tribunal.
