He further submits that it may take time for getting the permission and as such some reasonable time be granted for executing remedial measures and the inspection be postponed for such period. We accept his submission and expect the necessary permission to follow within three weeks from today. We therefore, direct the Joint Inspection Team to postpone the inspection of the said Let this order be premises by four weeks. communicated to the parties as well as SDM, Vasant Vihar, New Delhi for appropriate action.
