	in order to assess the construction carried out within 30/33 Mtrs.
	abutting the river course of river Kaliasot had superimposed the

Khasra Map upon the satellite imagery and identified the constructions which had come up on this No Construction Zone along the river site of river Kaliasote. It further revealed that show cause notices were issued to 18 developers/persons for carrying out construction on No Construction Zone along the Kaliasote river and asked for a cause why they should not be proceeded against for removal of those constructions in accordance with law. Today, it is reported that some of them have responded to the said notice and the process of hearing them is going on.

On 18.07.2014, Mr. Brajesh Sharma, Assistant Engineer, MPPCB was directed to inspect the places where the offending activity of construction was allegedly going on as pointed out by the Applicant along with photographs and to find out the factual situation existing at the said places. Accordingly, the site inspection was carried out on the same day and the report of such inspection has now been placed before us.

Perusal of the said report dated 18.07.2014 submitted by Mr. Brajesh Sharma, reveals that vestiges of fresh constructions in the river bed were found in the vicinity of the area developed by Sagar Premium Plaza and IBD(Indus Builders & Developers).

Considering this report, we feel that Sagar Premium Plaza, Indus Builders & Developers, are made party to the present petition to render complete and a effective justice to the parties. Let these builders/developers be impleaded as parties to the present application.
