	<p> Item No. 15 to 20 March 08, 2017 <small>R</small> </p>	<p> In furtherance to our order dated 07th March, 2017, Mr. Vinod Kumar Gupta, Additional Municipal Commissioner, Nagar Nigam Kanpur is present today. Therefore, the Bailable Warrant will not be executed against him. </p> <p> He is presently officiating the Commissioner of the Municipal Commissioner, Nagar Nigam Kanpur. He has stated that there are 110 wards and 1669 colonies in Kanpur city. Out of them, unplanned colonies are 152, while 397 are slums colonies and remaining are planned/ authorised colonies. The slums and illegal colonies have not been provided with any sewer line. The sewer or other discharge from these colonies and from the houses which </p>

are not provided the septic tanks is released into drains which meets the Corporation's drain and ultimately it goes to the river Ganga. He has not inspected or went around these 549 illegal and slum colonies. He has only inspected 80-90 colonies. In 80-90 colonies, there may be one or two industries carrying on their activity. He cannot say as to whether there is industrial or commercial activity going on in these 549 colonies though he had taken over as Additional Commissioner about two and a half years back. Even the remaining 1120 authorised colonies do not have sewer line and sewer connection and there is commercial activity or industrial activity being carried on in these 1120 colonies. Even their discharge effluent also comes in the Nigam's drain. Kesa Colony Drain Tapping, Khewra Drain, Roadways Colony Drain, Jogeshwar Drain Tapping and Jewra Drain Tapping including Nawabganj and Permiya Drain is under control of the Nigam. All these drains were got cleaned pre-monsoon 2016. This is done departmentally. Even for the current year, the work has already been started. The sludge taken out of the drain is taken to the site at Bhoti. He says that he would not be able to inform the Tribunal as to why despite what he has stated, if it is correct that 70% of the sewer line is blocked and is flowing only to 30% as we were informed yesterday by the Jal Nigam officer as well as the Members of the joint inspection team.
