Item No.1 September 19, 2014 Order No.8	<p>We have heard learned Counsel for parties.</p> <p>Inspite of several directions it is noticed that the compliance of direction, particularly, to improve the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP), within period of six (6) weeks and manage the disposal of Solid Waste, generated by the Casinos, is not duly complied with. Affidavit is filed by one Ms.Nila Mohanan, District Collector, North Goa, indicating certain reasons, which show that the amount has been deposited as per the final order of this Tribunal. It appears that remaining directions, particularly, direction Nos.1,2 and 5, are not yet duly complied with.</p> <p>There is no progress report filed by the Goa Pollution Control Board (GPCB), in order to show the compliance.</p> <p>The learned Counsel appearing for State of Goa, would submit that such report would be filed in due course of time. On behalf of the Respondent No.12, Amendment Application is filed. Let the Amendment Application and the copy of Judgment of this Tribunal, be forwarded to the Civil Court, Senior Division, North Goa, Panjim, with direction that it be registered as an Execution Petition by the Court of Civil Judge, Senior Division, Panjim, Goa, for the purpose of execution, under Section 25 (2) of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010. Learned Civil Judge, shall add the Caption of Ports, Goa, the Chairman of Goa Pollution Control Board and other parties, who are parties to the original Application and shall take immediate steps to proceed with execution of the Application. The parties to appear before the Executing Court on 1st October, 2014, and the Executing Court, shall dispensed with granting of any further date, because we have already informed the parties to appear and the Executing Court, may take due steps for compliance, as may be</p>

permissible under the Law. In the meanwhile, the compliance report may be submitted by State of Goa and Goa Pollution Control Board (GPCB), before the Tribunal as submitted by learned Counsel for State of Goa. The parties to appear before the Executing Court on 1st October, 2014. The Registrar to send the copies of the Judgment and other papers to the Executing Court.
