Tribunal it is obvious that the Ghaziabad Nagar Nigam may have done some work. But it is not as expected and drains still appear to be blocked due to MSW or the debris etc.

The officer present in the Tribunal undertakes that he will ensure that the obstruction in the drain is removed within three days and he will report compliance.

In view of the submission made by the Officers and assurance given by the Commissioner that in future no lapses will be committed, we grant one week time to clean all the drains as indicated in our earlier order and report compliance.

Post this case on 6th October, 2017 to consider the court commissioners report and the compliance report filed by the Ghaziabad Nagar Nigam.

Meanwhile, Ghaziabad Nagar Nigam shall also take required measures for preventing pollution and provide necessary medical assistance as may be required by the residents in the area.

The presence of the Commissioner of Ghaziabad Nagar Nigam is dispensed with.
