Order No. 4 20th January, 2015.	<p>Heard. Perused.</p> <p>On 16.01.2015 Respondent Nos. 1 & 2 against whom the Applicant has been pressing for orders of stay submit that he would be taking instructions and making a statement as to duly making of an application for consent to operate to the MPPCB and to abide by the terms and conditions that would be stipulated by the MPPCB for such consent. However, today none appears on behalf of the Respondent Nos. 1 & 2. We are told that yesterday also when the matter was to be listed none appeared on behalf of the Respondent No. 1 & 2.</p> <p>It is the case of the Applicant that the Respondent No. 1 & 2 are carrying on manufacturing of sweets and namkeen and other food materials on a mass scale on House No. 49 & 50, Amar Singh Marg, Freeganj, Ujjain thereby causing pollution which resulted nuisance to the local residents. Our attention is invited to the reports dtd. 18.01.2009, 18.01.2010 and 08.06.2010. Report dtd. 18.01.2010 of MPPCB and letter dtd. 08.06.2010 of Ujjain Municipal Corporation which point out the increase levels of BOD, COD and suspended solids in the sewerage generated by the Respondent No.1 and nuisance generated as a result of the</p>

activities carried out on the said premises.

Before we pass any orders we would like to have the latest view of the conditions prevailing on the premises in question. We therefore direct to MPPCB to carry out inspection of the said premises collect air and water samples and present detail report regarding the observance made along with the results of the analysis of the samples before us on the next date. Liberty is granted to the Applicant to remain present at the time of such inspection subject to the condition that he was not interfere in the inspection in any manner whatsoever and shall not give rise to any occasion of disturbance in law and order. The MPPCB may give notice of inspection to the Applicant in advance.

Let the matter be listed on **11th February, 2015.**
