He November submits that to answer the queries raised by the Tribunal, 22, 2016 SS he would need time to consult the records and submit a short note besides showing the slides and all the presentation if it becomes necessary for this purpose. We direct that Professor Dr. Vinod Tare along with Professor

Gussain and team would be present on 01st December, Item No. 2016 for final hearing of these matters. 27 to 29 November We further direct the Learned Counsel appearing for 22, 2016 Tannery Association of Jajmau to take clear instructions SS and inform the Tribunal as to why the industrial complex be not asked to be shifted to an appropriate site (plant industrial complex) with compete infrastructure and also to take clear instructions on how many total tannery industries are there in Jajmau and how many of them are lying closed. The Learned Counsel appearing for Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board has informed us that there are 400 tannery industries at Jajmau out of which 128 are lying closed as on 16th November, 2016 either under the orders of the Court, Tribunal or Pollution Control Board. He will also seek clear instructions as to how many tannery units are in Jajmau who have installed online system. We are informed by the Learned Counsel appearing for the respondents that there are only 120 industries who have installed flow meters and only flow meters are made available for online monitoring system. The Learned Counsel appearing for Central Pollution Control Board submits that they will file the complete report which has been prepared by the team headed by Member Secretary, Central Pollution Control Board in relation to the number of drains, quantum and quality of effluents therein during the course of the day. Copies be put up on the website of the Central Pollution Control

> Board if not already given to the parties so that all the parties before the Tribunal can download the same.

Learned Counsel for Central Pollution Control Board Item No. submits that the team headed by Member Secretary, 27 to 29 Central Pollution Control Board and the Central Pollution November 22, 2016 Control Board has done the entire work of sampling and SS analysis of samples.

The Ministry of Water Resources shall file the complete reports which have been directed by the Tribunal within one week from today and provide copies thereof to all the Learned Counsel appearing in this case and put those report on the website of the Ministry.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change would seek instructions completely with regard to ZLD and online system in view of the submissions that have been made on behalf of industry and other respondents. Learned Counsel appearing for Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board and Nigam will provide the requisite information on all the points that have been advanced before the Tribunal during the course of hearing in the last days.

The Ministry of Water Resources will file a complete note in response to the queries raised by the Tribunal. The Learned Counsel appearing State of Uttar Pradesh will take clear instructions on all the issues that have been deliberated upon today and file a note within one week from today. The Learned Counsel appearing for Jal Nigam along with officer who has physically conducted survey in relation to the report submitted by the Central Pollution Control Board shall furnish complete information on variation noticed. This should be done within three days
