inspection, may be a surprise inspection.

We make it clear that any person who now defaults our order would be dealt with in accordance with law. This direction is necessitated for the reason that time was granted twice but the order of the Tribunal has not been complied with for the one reason or the other.

With the above directions M.A. No. 197 of 2016 stands disposed of without any order as to cost.

Report would be submitted to the Tribunal and inspection should be conducted preferably within 10 days from today.
