Item No. 5 12th November, 2013	<p><u>M.A.No. 124/2013</u></p> <p>M.A.No. 124/2013 has been filed by the Learned Counsel for the respondent no. 1 seeking exemption from personal appearance as he has to proceed out of station today. The M.A. is allowed in view of the fact that compliance report has been filed in terms of the order of the Tribunal dated 30.08.2013.</p> <p>We have perused the compliance report and being satisfied with the steps taken by the respondent as indicated therein, we may only add that for the proper growth and survival of the trees planted in the urban areas, the steps which have been indicated in our order dated 30.08.2013 need to be kept in mind as has already been stated in the Judgement of the Principal Bench, NGT, New Delhi so as to ensure proper aeration to the root system and percolation of water into the soil to be available to the trees. The Department of Housing & Environment and Urban Administration & Development Department must ensure that such kind of indifference is not shown while carrying out the task of paving roads and creating footpaths in the urban areas whereby trees are totally covered with concrete or tiles and tar preventing seepage of water into the ground and chocking the trees.</p> <p>In view of the compliance report, the matter is accordingly consigned to record.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">.....JM (DALIP SINGH)</p>
