Perused.</p> <p>The Applicant submits that not only the quality of the fuel and its utilization but also the extent of its utilization are material in regulating the pollution generated through the use of vehicles. It is for this reason that the response of Respondent Nos. 3 and 5 are necessary. Learned Counsel appearing for Respondent Nos. 3 and 5 submits that the response on behalf of Respondent No. 3 would be filed within a week and as regards the Respondent No. 5 (Ministry of Finance), he submits that there has been poor response to his requisitions for instructions.</p> <p>We direct the Respondent No. 5 (Ministry of Finance) to provide necessary instructions to the Counsel appearing on their behalf for preparation of the requisite response. If the difficulty as expressed by the learned Counsel vis-à-vis Respondent No. 5 (Ministry of Finance) persists, we will be compelled to take coercive measures as deem fit on the next date of hearing.</p> <p>Learned Counsel appearing for Respondent No. 5 to communicate this order to the Ministry of Finance. Time for filing response is granted. Response be filed within a week with advance copy to the learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant. Rejoinder, if any, thereto be filed within one week thereafter.</p> <p>List the matter on 3rd September, 2014.</p>
