Item No. 3 March 7, 2014	<p>The Learned Counsel appearing for the applicant Mr. R. Venkataraman has fairly submitted that he will serve all the papers to the newly added parties through their respective Counsel.</p> <p>The learned Counsel appearing for the Uttar Pradesh Government would submit that he has received the list of water bodies in the District Ghaziabad but it is in Hindi and he is translating the same and would file it thereafter.</p> <p>So far as it relates to the steps taken for the purpose of removal of encroachment and also the individual orders passed for the purpose of removal of construction which are put up in the water bodies, he would also seek time to file details about the same by the next date of hearing.</p> <p>We also make it clear that along with the same, the Government shall also file its action plan for the purpose of removal and rehabilitation measures which the Government proposes.</p>
