No. 739 of 2016</p> <p>The Applicants-RG Stone Urology & Laparoscopy Hospital, East of Kailash and RG Stone Hospital, Pitampura, are seeking cancellation of bailable warrants issued against the Medical Superintendents of the said hospitals.</p> <p>The order dated 15-07-2016 directing issuance of bailable warrants was passed as there were no representations on behalf of the hospitals and the information regarding installation of rain water harvesting system in the hospitals was not coming forth.</p> <p>Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the hospitals submits that RWHS is yet to be installed at East of Kailash hospital as the approval of the drawing for installation within the premises of the East of Kailash hospital is awaited. He further submits that RWHS is already in place in the premises of Pitampura hospital. He undertakes on behalf of the hospitals to remain present before the Tribunal on the given dates</p>

and participate in the proceedings duly braced with necessary instructions.

We, therefore, cancel theailable warrants issued against the Medical Superintendents of the R. G. Stone hospital East of Kailash and R. G. Stone hospital of Pitampura.

The M. A. No. 738 of 2016 and M. A. No. 739 of 2016 stand disposed of accordingly.
