The compensation is to be paid to Delhi Pollution Control Committee within 3 weeks from today. It is made clear that the environmental compensation awarded is for causing the environmental degradation till this day and the question of payment for the subsequent period will be considered later

The joint inspection team is direct to inspect the site and find out whether the rain water harvesting system is in order.

. The inspection be carried out with prior notice. It is made clear that if the DJB on inspection finds that the site is not suitable for the proposed rain water harvesting system or the structure as such cannot be permitted as not according to the design approved, there need not be a joint inspection.

Let the report be submitted to the Tribunal on or before 17.03.2016.
